- **Missions Fund** (Support missionaries supported and managed by ACEM)
- **Building Fund** (Pay the principal and interest of the loan for 105GC)
- **Benevolence Fund** (Donations to external organizations and special causes)
- **Repair & Repair (R+R) Fund** (used specifically for repair and renovation to the 100 Acadia building. Please mark your donation as “OTHER: R+R” on the website or envelope to donate here)
