Self-identity: Located in the Greater Toronto Area TCCC is a local, multi-congregational, multilingual Christian church, with ethnic Chinese roots, that operates both a house of worship (@100 Acadia) and a community centre (@105 Gibson).

Mission: The mission of TCCC is to grow missional disciples of Jesus Christ to impact the world through compassion and reconciliation.

Pastoring: We serve and minister to everyone, irrespective of race, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, language, socio-economic status, political stance, religious background or level of spiritual maturity [Jn 13:34–35; 1 Pet 3:8]. Title: Youth/Young Family Pastor

The Toronto Christian Community Church is a Chinese church with four congregations: Cantonese, English, Mandarin and Children. The total worshipper each Sunday is numbered at about 1,500. We are in search of a full-time Mandarin ministry pastor who has the burden to shepherd the Mandarin-speaking youths (aged roughly from 15 and 30) and young families with small children.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Major (60% effort)
 - Develop strategies and execute plans to grow ministry for youths and to establish ministry for young families, who are either born in or immigrated into Canada
 - Develop and implement plans to meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of the youths and the young families
 - Recruit, equip and empower young leaders
 - > Have the enthusiasm for outreach and bring youths to faith through evangelism
 - Recruit and equip adults as mentors for the youths and young families
- Minor (40% effort)
 - > Build and maintain close connection with congregants through intentional discipleship
 - > Participate in preaching, Sunday School teaching, and small group/fellowship gathering
 - Attend meetings at congregational and church level
 - Other duties assigned by Lead Pastor or Senior Pastor as the needs arise

QUALIFICATION REQUIRED

- A person of faith and integrity with good relationship with the Lord in personal life and in ministry
- A clear calling to serve the Mandarin-speaking youths and young families
- A graduate from an accredited seminary with MDiv., prior experience in working with youths and young families highly preferred
- A team player with willingness to be supervised
- Fluent in Mandarin, good command of English a must
- In alignment with the church statement of faith
- Pass background check prior to employment

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

The Youth/Young Family Pastor will report to the Lead Pastor of the Mandarin congregation.

FUTURE PERSPECTIVE

The Youth/Young Family Pastor will have the opportunity to take other ministerial roles upon successfully demonstrating the required capacities.
